High-performing schools result in high-performing students, and green schools go far beyond bricks and mortar. The Kansas City Public School District operates 35 schools and centers that were built over a one-hundred year period beginning in the 1890s. In recent years, KCPS participated in a public-private partnership to address building maintenance and efficiency issues in KCPS buildings. These efforts resulted in dramatically improved energy performance in most of the schools, doubling their ENERGY STAR® scores. The energy saved at Kansas City Public Schools during the last two years would be enough to annually power 3,800 average homes, affecting over 3.7 million square feet of space.

USGBC Central Plains serves western Missouri and all of Kansas, and is a part of the U.S. Green Building Council, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit established to ensure, healthy, high performance buildings for all within this generation.
